Fire

- Witek met with Andres Billing Service and they are recommending a flat ambulance billing rate
 of \$1,900.00. This would consolidate the transport fee to one flat rate, no matter the level of
 service, and it is expected to increase revenue. We would continue to write off any unpaid
 balance for our residents. Eichelberger made a motion to adjust the billing fee to a flat rate of

- Snowplow bids for the 17-18 season were received by 2 bidders. Bidder A was \$50 for each sidewalks, plowing & salting. Bidder B ranged from \$115-\$282 per push and \$165 per ton for salt.
